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Michael Kalafatas was the director of admissions at Brandeis University for a quarter century. He is the author of three books, including The Bellstone: The Greek Sponge Divers of the Aegean, One American's Journey Home. He also served as executive producer of the documentary film, Pushing the Limits: The Story of Greek Sponge Diving, now part of the Immersion Presents marine science film series created by undersea explorer Dr. Robert Ballard. His maternal grandparents hailed from Eastern Thrace where the nine-year period (1914-1923) of the genocide of the Greeks in Turkey began on "Black Easter," April 6, 1914.

Nick Larigakis is president of the American Hellenic Institute, a non-profit Greek American public policy center and think tank. The AHI works to strengthen relations between the United States and Greece and Cyprus and within the Greek American community. Larigakis initiated the AHI's The Future of Hellenism in America annual conferences in 2002 and annually leads the AHI Foundation's Student Foreign Policy Trip to Greece and Cyprus.

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
